

1.15 Clery Act Your Right To Know Campus Crime Statistics

The public safety of the College community is very important to Delaware Technical Community College. In compliance with the federal Jeanne Clery Disclosure of Campus Policy and Campus Crime Statistics Act of 1998 ("Clery Act") and in order to communicate information related to the College's public safety efforts, the College maintains a Public Safety Website. This website includes Campus Crime Statistics Report outlining crimes reported on each campus, in off-campus buildings, at/on property owned or controlled by Delaware Technical Community College, and on public property immediately adjacent to and accessible from campus. In compliance with the requirements of the Clery Act, it also includes: information regarding the law enforcement authority of campus Public Safety Departments; policies concerning campus public safety, such as crime prevention, alcohol and drug use, sexual assault; Delaware Sex Offender Registry; and how to report crimes which may occur on campus.

In addition to viewing the Crime Statistics report on the website, a copy of the report may be obtained from each Campus Administrative Services Office.
