#### I. SCOPE

This policy amendment applies to students who are eligible for VA education benefits for dependents and survivors.

### II. POLICY STATEMENT

Delaware Tech recognizes the sacrifice of active-duty military personnel and those who have served in the United States Armed Forces. The College offers many active-duty and veteran-friendly services to assist our country's soldiers and veterans in their educational success.

This Residency Policy update addresses Section 1018 of Public Law 116-315 by adding Chapter 35 recipients to the definitions of covered individuals to be charged in-state tuition effective August 1, 2022. Chapter 35 refers to the Veteran Affairs education benefits for survivors and dependents.

### III. POLICY

- 11. United States Armed Forces veterans (Veterans) or related individuals are exempt from the six (6) month residency requirement above. They are considered in-state residents for tuition purposes so long as the student:
  - a. Has a residence in Delaware (regardless of duration); and
  - b. Is utilizing educational assistance under Chapter 31, Veteran Readiness and Employment; or
  - c. Is utilizing educational assistance under Chapter 35, Survivors' and Dependents' Educational Assistance; or
  - d. Receives Montgomery and post 9/11 GI Bill educational assistance; and

- i. Enrolls within three (3) years of student's discharge after the student served 90 days or more on active duty; or
- ii. Enrolls, using transferred entitlement, within three (3) years of the transferor's discharge after the transferor served 90 days or more on active duty;
- iii. Remains continuously enrolled after initially meeting the requirements of this subparagraph and is using assistance provided under Chapter 30 or 33 of Title 38 of the United States Code.
- iv. Enrolls as a Surviving Spouse or Child under the Fry Scholarship (38 U.S.C. §3311(b)(9)).
- v. Enrolls using transferred entitlement, and the transferor is a member of the uniformed service who is serving on active duty.
- e. The policy shall be read to be amended as necessary to comply with the requirements of Public Law 117-68 and Public Law 116-315 as amended.

# IV. EFFECTIVE DATE(S)

This policy is effective August 1, 2022.

## V. FREQUENCY OF REVIEW AND UPDATE

This policy will be reviewed and updated bi-annually.
